At LifeScienceBoard.com, we believe in being clear and open about how we use your information. In the spirit of transparency, this policy provides detailed information about how and when we use cookies.

Does LifeScienceBoard.com use cookies?

Yes. As described in the [“Cookies and Log Files”](#) section of our [Privacy Policy](#), we use cookies and other technologies to ensure everyone who uses LifeScienceBoard.com has the best possible experience. Cookies also help us keep your account safe.

By continuing to use our services, you are agreeing to the use of cookies and similar technologies for the purposes we describe in this policy.

What is a cookie?

A cookie is a small file placed onto your device that enables LifeScienceBoard.com features and functionality. For example, cookies enable us to identify your device, secure your access to LifeScienceBoard.com and our sites generally, and even know if someone attempts to access your account from a different device. Cookies also enable you to easily share content on LifeScienceBoard.com and help us serve relevant ads to you.

When does LifeScienceBoard.com use cookies?

We use cookies on our websites, [www.LifeScienceBoard.com](#), and mobile applications in the near future. Any browser loading these sites will receive cookies from us. For LifeScienceBoard.com registered and non-registered users, we also place cookies in your browser when you visit non-LifeScienceBoard.com sites that host our plugins (for example, LifeScienceBoard.com's "Share" button) unless you opt out.

What types of cookies does LifeScienceBoard.com use?

We use two types: persistent cookies and session cookies. A persistent cookie helps us recognize you as an existing registered user, so it's easier to return to LifeScienceBoard.com without signing in again. After you sign in, a persistent cookie stays in your browser and will be read by LifeScienceBoard.com when you return to the site. Session cookies only last for as long as the session (usually the current visit to a web site or a browser session).

What are cookies used for?

Cookies can be used to do lots of different things, like recognize you when you visit LifeScienceBoard.com, remember your preferences, and give you a personalized experience that's in line with your settings. Cookies also make your interactions with LifeScienceBoard.com more secure and faster. Additionally, cookies allow us to bring you advertising both on and off the LifeScienceBoard.com site, and bring customized features to you through LifeScienceBoard.com plugins such as our "Share" button.

Authentication	If you're signed in to LifeScienceBoard.com, cookies help us show you the right information and personalize your experience.
Security	We use cookies to enable and support our security features, and to help us detect malicious activities and violations of our User Agreement.
Preferences, features and services	Cookies can tell us which language you prefer and what your communications preferences are. They can help you fill out forms on LifeScienceBoard.com more easily. They also provide you with features, insights, and customized content in conjunction with our plugins. You can learn more about plugins in our Privacy Policy.
Advertising	We may use cookies to show you relevant advertising both on and off the LifeScienceBoard.com site. We may also use a cookie to learn whether user who saw an ad on LifeScienceBoard.com later visited the advertiser's site. Similarly, our partners may use a cookie to determine whether we've shown an ad and how it performed, or provide us with information about how you interact with ads. We may also work with a partner to show you an ad on or off LifeScienceBoard.com, such as after you've visited a partner's site or application.
Performance, Analytics and Research	Cookies help us learn how well our site and plugins perform in different locations. We also use cookies to understand, improve, and research products, features, and services, including when you access LifeScienceBoard.com from other websites, applications, or devices such as your work computer or your mobile device.

Please note that the names of cookies, pixels and other technologies may change over time.

Controlling cookies

Most browsers allow you to control cookies through their settings preferences. However, if you limit the ability of websites to set cookies, you may worsen your overall user experience, since it will no longer be personalized to you. It may also stop you from saving customized settings like login information.

What to do if you don't want cookies to be set

If you don't want us to use cookies when you visit LifeScienceBoard.com, you can opt out of some cookies on your browser settings. In order for us to recognize that you have opted out of cookies, we have to place our LifeScienceBoard.com opt-out cookie on your device so we can know not to set other LifeScienceBoard.com cookies the next time you visit. If you do not want to receive cookies, you can also change your browser settings on your computer or other device you're using to access our services. If you use LifeScienceBoard.com without changing your browser settings, we'll assume that you're happy to receive all cookies on the LifeScienceBoard.com website. Please note that the LifeScienceBoard.com site will not work properly without cookies.
